Please be advised that we are scheduled to administer the NJSLA assessments to third, fourth, fifth, and sixth graders on the following dates:

ELA:

- Grades 5 and 6 on Monday, April 20th and Tuesday, April 21st
- Grades 3 and 4 on Wednesday, April 22nd and Friday, April 24th

Math:

- Grades 5 and 6 on Monday, April 27th, Tuesday, April 28th, and Thursday, April 30th
- Grades 3 and 4 on Monday, May 4th, Tuesday, May 5th, and Wednesday, May 6th Science:
 - Grade 5 on Friday, May 1st and Thursday, May 7th

Make-ups will be administered throughout the month of May.

All testing will be completed in the morning. While it is always important that students report to school punctually, it is especially important on these dates since students who arrive after testing has begun will not be permitted to test with their class on that date. Instead, the tardy student will report to another classroom until that day of testing concludes. He or she would then make up the day of missed testing during a scheduled make-up day.

For the same reasons, we ask that you make no appointments for your child, such as a dental or doctor's appointment, for any of the dates that your child is scheduled to test. Assuming that your child is healthy enough to report to school, he or she is best served by taking the state assessment with his or her class according to the schedule noted above.

To get your child off to a good start on each test date, please assure that he or she receives plenty of sleep the night before. Likewise, assure that your child eats a light, healthy breakfast each morning.
