- Students are to log into https://www.ixl.com/signin/saddlebrooksd using the login information sent to their parent's email. Any child that did not receive a login, may contact Toni Violetti at tvioletti@sbpsnj.org. The IXL site is accessible via a computer or their free app.
- o If using the app, please add @saddlebrooksd to their username to log in.
- Once you log in, all students are asked to work on the Diagnostic (by clicking on Diagnostic at the top). Please spend about 15 minutes for the first time. The information the program receives from your child's performance on the Diagnostic will help create their Recommendation Wall. Your child may revisit the diagnostic at any time to receive further recommendations on skills and topics.
- Each student is asked to work on IXL for a minimum of one hour per week. You can divide this hour
