

New Jersey is under a declared state of emergency.

Pursuant to Public Law P.L. 1975, c. 231, which was approved by the Governor on March 20, 2020, during a period declared as a state of emergency a public body shall be permitted to perform any of the following by means of communication or other electronic equipment: conduct a meeting and any public business to be conducted thereat, cause a meeting to be open to the public, vote, or receive public comment without being deemed to have violated the provision of P.L.1975, c.231 (C.10:4-6 et seq.) in performing such functions by means of communication or other electronic equipment.

Pursuant to same, the Saddle Brook Board of Education will hold its regularly scheduled meetings and special meetings completely remotely. No member of the public will be permitted to attend in-person.

The Board meetings will be livestreamed and able to be viewed using the Zoom platform. Any member of the public can join the meeting and their will be a public comment session.
